Activity 4 - Photo investigation



Real people - life in Rio de Janeiro

Pupils are presented with a cropped image and use the activity shapes to imagine what might be outside the photo. Using a second un-cropped photo and information card they can write about what they've found out. Pupils could share their photos and responses with the class.
