‘ I just couldn't believe that was accurate - and now I know how the data was collected, I understand whether to believe the headline'

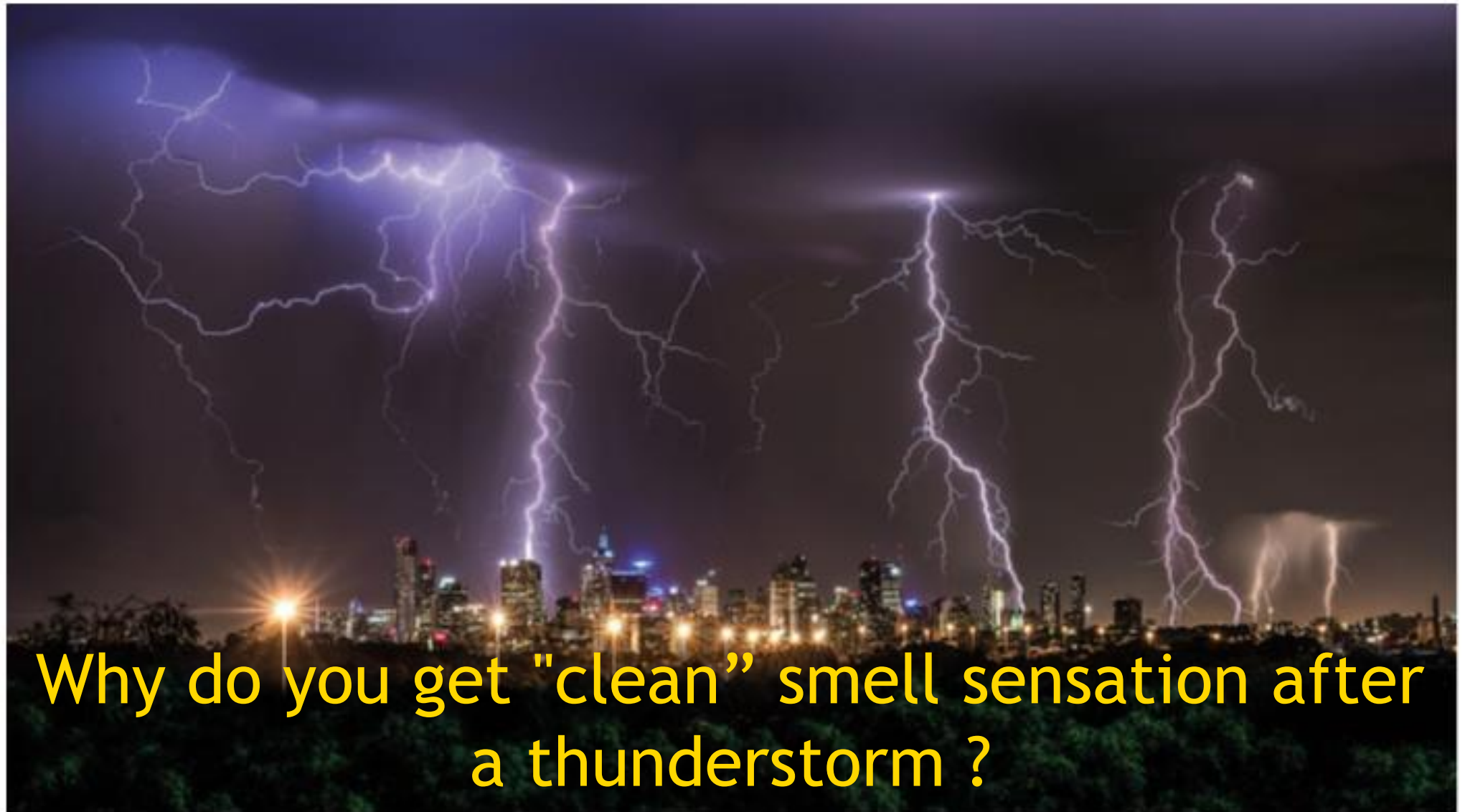
