Joseph Joffo, l'auteur du roman autobiographique "Un sac de billes", est mort à l'âge de 87 ans

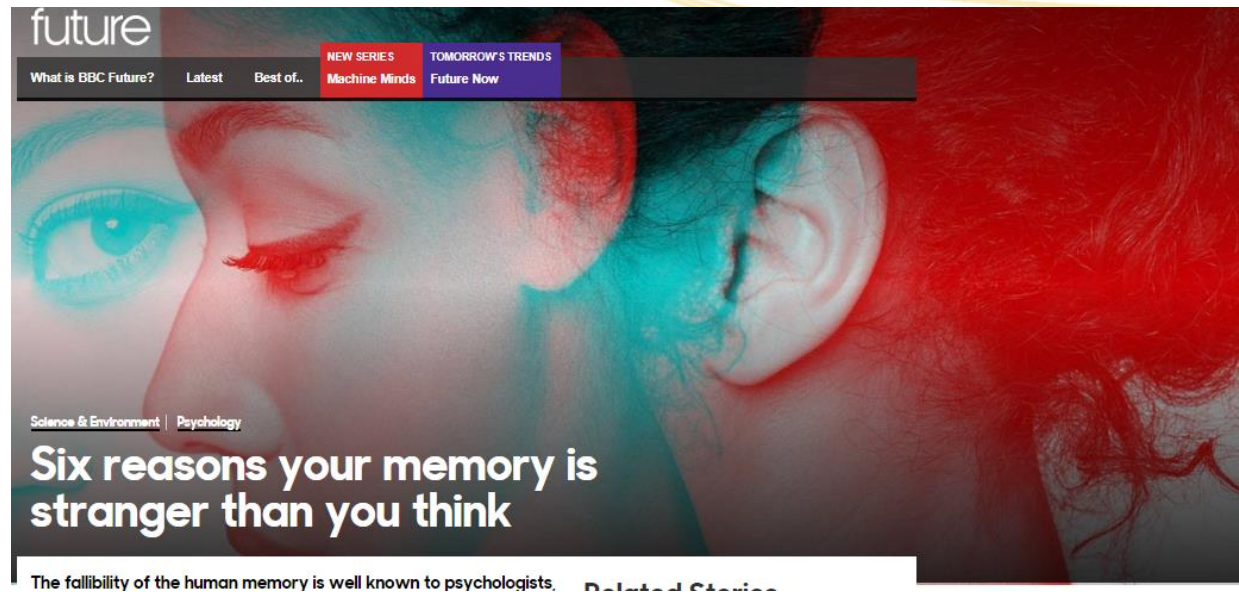
L'écrivain et scénariste avait été récompensé par l'Académie française, en 1974, pour ce roman racontant son enfance.

Joseph Joffo, l'auteur d'*Un sac de billes*, est mort à l'âge de 87 ans, annonce sa famille jeudi 6 décembre. Originaire de Paris, l'écrivain et scénariste était malade depuis quelques années. Il est mort à Saint-Laurent-du-Var (Alpes-Maritimes), où il était hospitalisé, a précisé son fils Franck Joffo.

L'écrivain avait été récompensé en 1974 par l'Académie française, pour son roman autobiographique sorti un an plus tôt. *Un sac de billes* raconte l'enfance de Joseph Joffo et de son frère Maurice, entre 1941 et 1944, alors que ces deux enfants juifs doivent fuir à travers la France occupée par l'Allemagne. Ce roman a fait l'objet de deux adaptations cinématographiques, en 1975 et 2017.

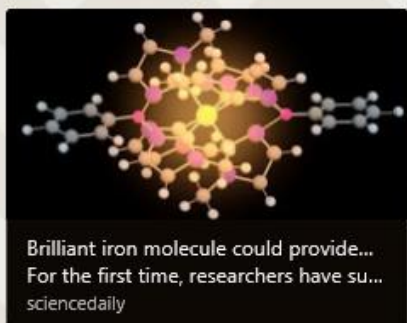

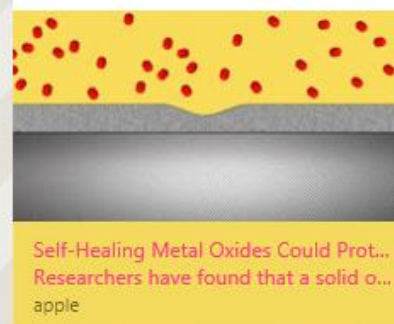
