

In books containing words linked to learned graphemes and phonemes...

In age-appropriate books...

- 1. Reading accurately by blending the sounds in words that contain the common graphemes for all 40+ phonemes.
- 2. Reading accurately some / most words of two or more syllables that contain learned graphemes and phonemes.
- 3. Reading many / most common exception words.
- 4. Reading aloud many words quickly, accurately and fluently without sounding and blending over 90 words a minute.
- 5. Sounding out many / most unfamiliar words accurately without undue hesitation.





In a familiar book they can already read accurately...
In a book they are reading independently...

- 1. Verbally making inferences based on what is being said and done.
- 2. Checking the text makes sense to them.
- 3. Predicting what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far.
- 4. Making links between the book they are reading and other books they have read.
