



In 1967 the leader called Dubcek who introduced 'Socialism with a human face' in his country while maintaining communist beliefs. This was the first step to happen the following year at a member of the Politburo defying the Soviet Union. It gave them hope that perhaps if Czechoslovakia could break free from the manacles of communism, so could other countries.

However, the USSR's new leader, Brezhnev did not simply stand by. He began to hold very public military training exercises right outside of Czechoslovakia's border and started to consider economic sanctions. This increased tensions around the world as other countries started to fear a repetition of the events that occurred in Hungary not so long ago that brought more fear to the lives of so many. However hope was still in the air with Dubcek speaking of 'socialism with a face' which was perhaps a sign of change for the better.
