

1. TEACHING QUALITY MORE IMPORTANT THAN METHOD OF DELIVERY:

- a. **EXPLICIT INSTRUCTION** that builds on students' prior knowledge (small steps, modelling)
- b. **SCAFFOLDING** – plan for support to guide practice, then challenge e.g. support videos, scaffolded resources, breakout rooms, worked examples

5. USE LOW STAKES ASSESSMENT AND QUIZZING TO AID RETRIEVAL:

- a. **SOCRATIVE PRO** enables the student to practise & informs planning
- b. **SENECA LEARNING & OAK ACADEMY** has built in quizzes that are automatically marked
- c. **QUIZZIZ** aids responsive planning and exposes misconceptions

2. PEER INTERACTION IMPROVES MOTIVATION:

- a. Find ways that students can work together e.g. **COLLABORATE** on a Keynote or Padlet
- b. Create opportunities for 'DISCUSSION' e.g. chat function in Showbie, breakout rooms

BEST PRACTICE IN REMOTE TEACHING

3. SUPPORT STUDENTS IN WORKING INDEPENDENTLY:

- a. Provide **STRATEGIES OR STRUCTURE** to support this e.g. checklists or planning tools
- b. Offer **SUPPORT** remotely or **MODELLED EXAMPLES** to promote independence

4. REFLECT ON THE RIGHT TOOL FOR THE TOPIC BEING TAUGHT:

- a. Consider topics that are better taught **FACE TO FACE VS REMOTELY**
- b. Think about the nature of the task set: **WHICH REMOTE LEARNING TOOL** is best?
- c. Using **GAMES** for learning is the best strategy to acquire vocabulary
