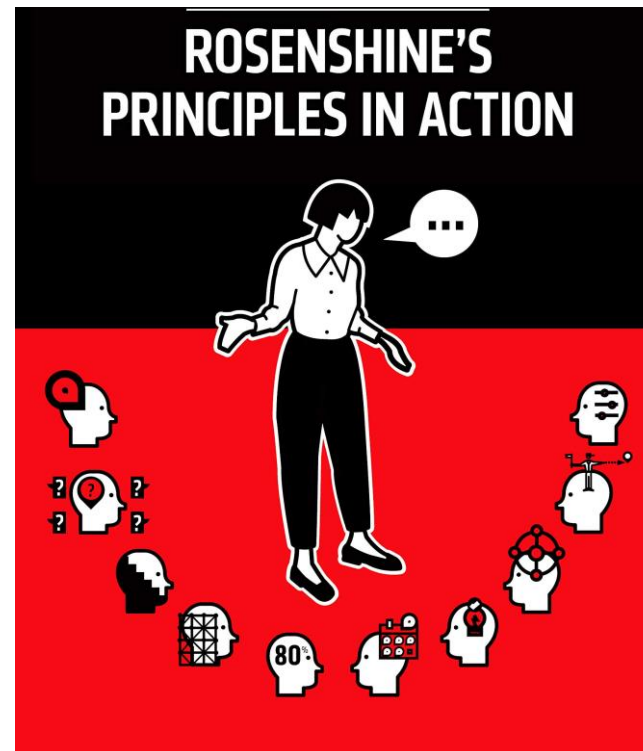


2. Teaching quality is more important than how lessons are delivered

- Clear explanations, scaffolding and feedback are key
- Explanations should build on pupils' prior learning
- There is no evidence that there is a difference in real time teaching (“synchronous teaching”) compared to alternatives (“asynchronous teaching”).

Quality of Explanation & Instruction

- Give clear and detailed instructions
- Provide a 'road map' for the lesson
- New material presented in small steps
- Explanations build on students' prior learning

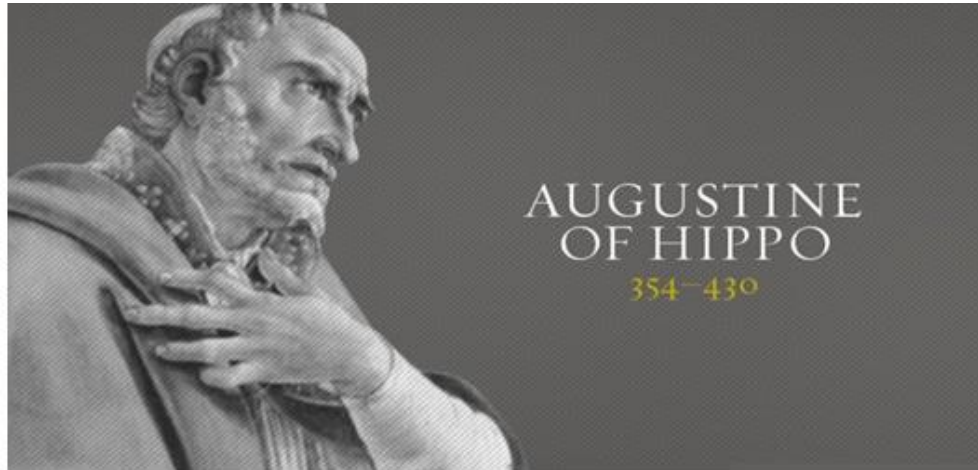

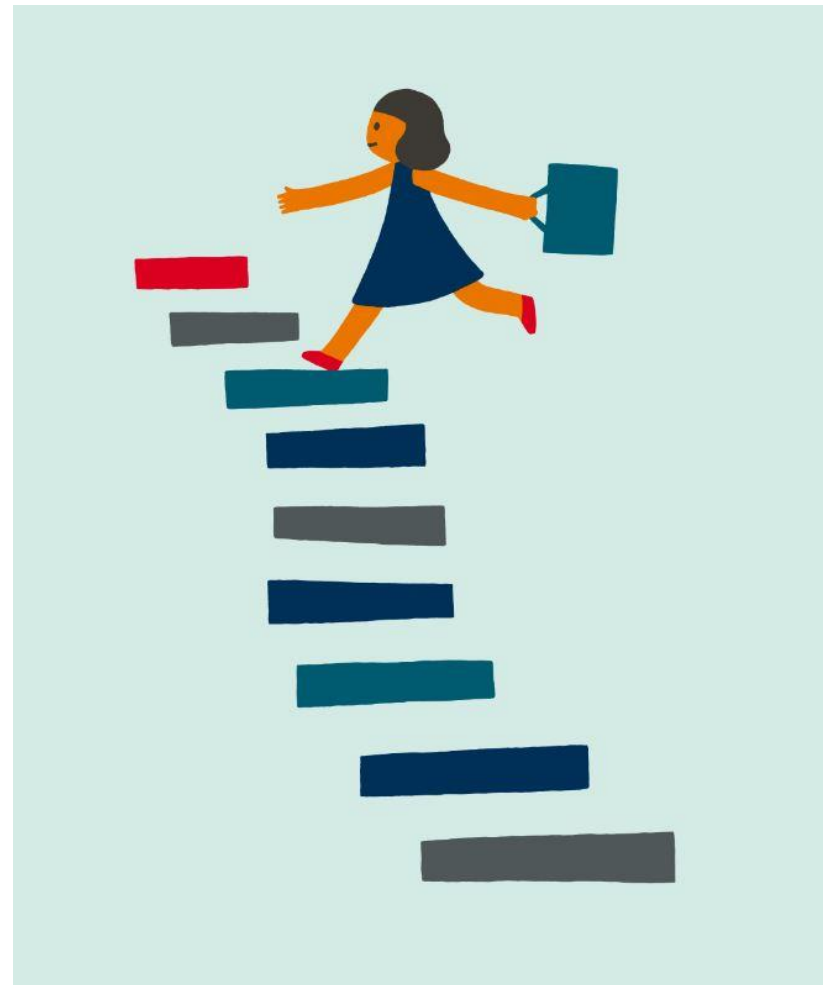

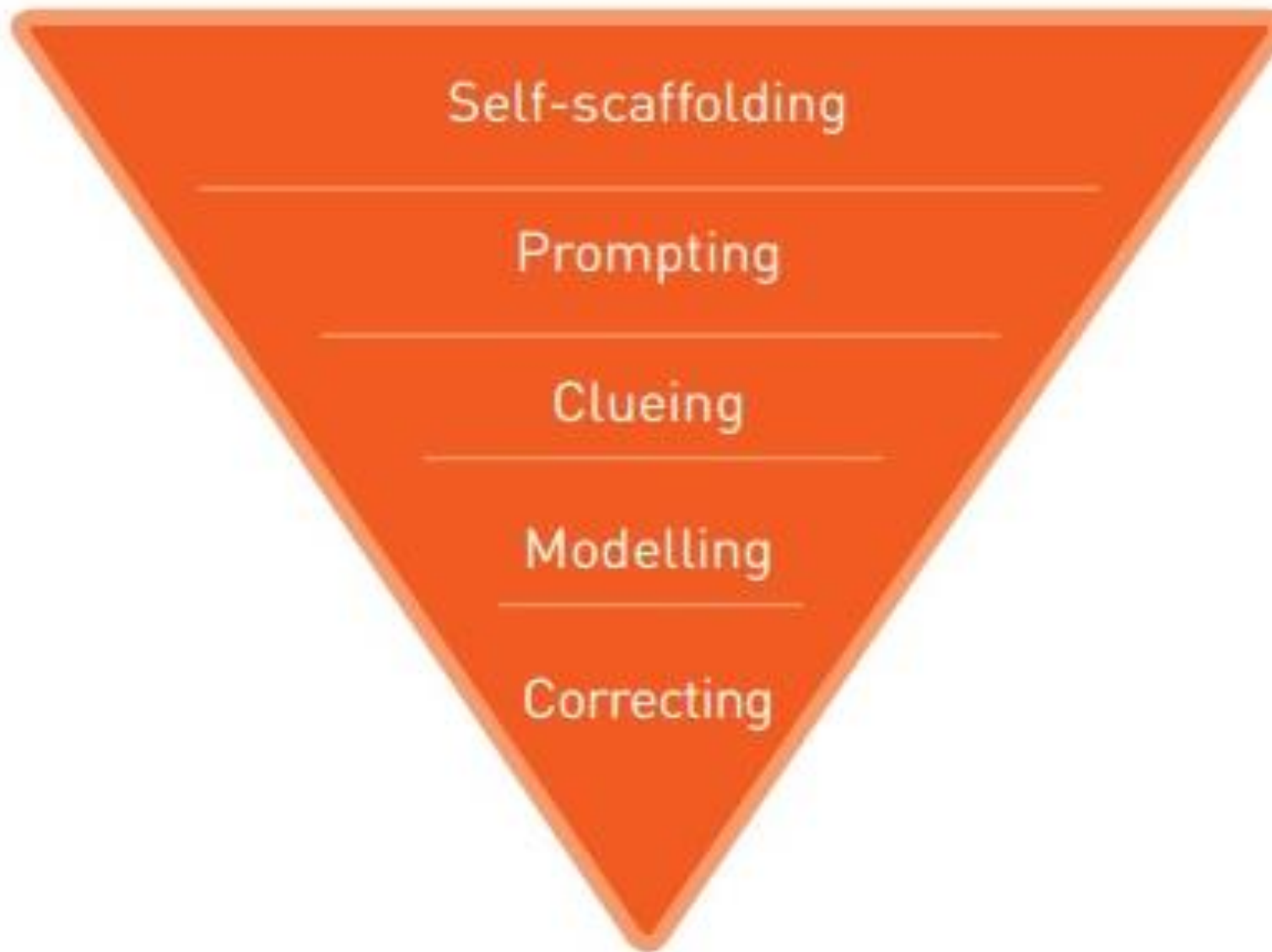
