

Do

- Ensure children use 90% of the room.
- Have unrestricted views of the outside.
- Clear desks and worktops.
- Have a low sensory space eg. a tent or reading corner.
- Limit displays to display boards.
- Use low contrast tonal colour eg. blue backing paper and a darker straight blue border.
- Represent the children.
- Have visuals eg. timetables, now and next, noise-o-meters.
- Label cupboards with words and pictures.
- Open windows- create air flow.
- Be flexible about how the children use the space to suit their needs.

Don't

- Have any clutter.
- Stick anything on the windows.
- Hang displays from ceilings.
- Use metallics and corrugated wavy display board edging.
- Stick displays on all available walls.
- Keep the room too hot.
- Put the lights on if its sunny.
- Use air fresheners or synthetic smells.
